

# Cleburne County Schools Virtual Learning Program Procedures / Application



## Eligibility Requirements

- The Virtual Learning Option is available for students in **grades 8 – 12** only if they have a **medically diagnosed, life-endangering condition, extreme personal hardship**, or another **committee-approved justifiable case**.
- **Students who have recently failed classes may not qualify** for the Virtual Learning Option.
- **Students with truancy issues may not qualify** for the Virtual Learning Option.
- **The Virtual Learning Committee reserves the right to review and make decisions on a case-by-case basis** for individual students, ensuring that all determinations align with academic policies, student needs, and overall program integrity.
- **All decisions made by the Virtual Learning Committee are final.**

## Program Details

- Students in **grades 8 – 12** will complete courses through **Imagine Edgenuity**.
- **Advanced/Honors classes are not guaranteed.**
- Students enrolled in the Virtual Program option will be deemed **nontraditional students**. Per this designation, nontraditional students are **not eligible to receive Honor Graduate awards** (i.e. Valedictorian, Salutatorian, Historian, or Top Ten).

## Participation/Attendance Requirements

- **Students must spend at least 15 hours per week actively working on Imagine Edgenuity.**
- **Idle time will not count toward the 15 hour requirement.** The system will track active engagement, including progress on assignments, quizzes, and lessons.
- If the **15 hour weekly minimum** cannot be met for any reason, an **email excuse** explaining the reason(s) must be sent to [kboyd@cleburneschools.net](mailto:kboyd@cleburneschools.net). There must be a **valid reason** (ex. sickness, death in the family, legal reason).
- **Only three (3) excuses** will be accepted for the school year. If a student does not meet the time requirement for a **fourth (4) time**, the **student may be removed** from the Virtual Program and be **required to attend in-person learning** at his/her home school.
- Students must **actively engage in coursework** and complete assignments on time.
- **Parents/Guardians are responsible** for ensuring students stay on track academically.
- Students **must attend** his/her home school in-person for all **state standardized testing**.

## College and Career Readiness

- Each student aspiring to attain the Alabama High School Diploma: General Education Pathway must earn one or more of the following college and career readiness indicators:
  - Earning a benchmark score in any subject area on the ACT® college entrance exam.
  - Earning a qualifying score of three or higher on an Advanced Placement® exam.
  - Earning a qualifying score of four or higher on an International Baccalaureate® exam.
  - Earning college credit while in high school.
  - Earning a silver or gold level on the ACT® WorkKeys® Exam.
  - Completing an in-school youth apprenticeship program.
  - Earning a career technical industry credential listed on the compendium of valuable credentials of the Alabama Committee on Credentialing and Career Pathways.
  - Being accepted into the military before graduation.
  - Attaining Career and Technical Education (CTE) completer status.
  - Any additional College and Career Readiness (CCR) indicator approved by the Alabama State Board of Education.
- If a student enrolled in the Virtual Learning Program has **not** earned a **College and Career Readiness Indicator**, they must be prepared to complete a **dual enrollment course** as part of their enrollment. This course may require on campus learning until completed.

## Application Process

1. Guardians must submit a **completed application** and **all necessary medical documentation** to:

2. All documentation will be reviewed and validated.
3. The **Virtual Learning Committee** will evaluate the request to determine if virtual learning is **necessary**.
4. **Before being considered as part of the Virtual Learning Program, the student and a parent/guardian must attend a mandatory orientation meeting.** This meeting will cover program expectations, platform usage, and participation requirements.
5. Parents/Guardians will be notified of the committee's decision after the orientation and review process.
6. **Students must re-apply each year for the Virtual Program Learning Option.** The Virtual Program Committee will meet to discuss participation each year.

## Additional Requirements

- **Doctor's Documentation:** If the request is based on medical necessity, a doctor's letter may be required.

## Program Removal & Review

- Students **failing to meet the 15-hour weekly requirement** on Imagine Edgenuity for **four (4) weeks (consecutive/non-consecutive)** may be **removed from the program**.
- Attendance, participation, and performance will be **regularly reviewed** to ensure student success.
- If a student does not meet expectations, they may be required to **return to in-person learning**.
- **The Virtual Learning Committee reserves the right to review and make decisions on a case-by-case basis** for individual students, ensuring that all determinations align with academic policies, student needs, and overall program integrity.
- If a **student has been removed** from the Virtual Learning Program, **he/she is ineligible for all future consideration** for participation in the program.
- **All decisions made by the Virtual Learning Committee are final.**
